

## **CITY OF FREDERICKTOWN BURNING SEASON REGULATIONS**

According to Section 255.180 of the Code of Ordinances, **RESIDENTS** of the City of Fredericktown may be permitted and allowed to burn yard and garden trimmings only (no branches larger than one inch in diameter) on **residential** lots. Burning seasons and times are as follows: Between 10:00 am and 6:00 pm daily from March 1<sup>st</sup> to April 30<sup>th</sup> and October 15<sup>th</sup> through December 15<sup>th</sup> of each year. In addition, the City asks residents **not** to burn on any sidewalks or asphalt. To prevent drainage problems, do not leave/place any debris in ditches. Commercial customers are not allowed to burn without a permit from the Missouri Department of Natural Resources. Any violation of the burn ordinance is subject to a fine not to exceed five hundred dollars (\$500), or imprisonment for a period not exceeding three (3) months, or both such fine and imprisonment.
